#### **RULES:**

- ◆ Print the comments from the table above. Choose about 15 comments from the 25 options that you think would be fun for your group.
- ◆ Cut the comment slips apart and place them in a Christmas bag or box.
- ◆ At the party - Everyone begins with the gift that they brought to the party (or any gift).
- ◆ Everyone sits in a large group.
- ◆ The leader will randomly draw a slip of paper and read it out loud. Each person that agrees with what has been read should then stand. Each standing person must trade gifts with another person who is standing.
- ◆ The leader should continue to draw slips of paper and read them aloud. Each time the appropriate people should stand and trade gifts. *(Note you may want to have people prove that they are "trade worthy". Ex: Actually do a cartwheel!)*
- ◆ No one can trade gifts with the same person more than one time.
- ◆ When you get towards the end of drawing slips – announce the number remaining. For example – "There are only 5 chances left to trade gifts."
- ◆ I think it's fun to purposely put the "love Jesus" one last. ;-)
